



TRAVEL

By Air: The nearest airport to Nottingham is East Midlands Airport. Birmingham and Manchester airports also have good transport links to Nottingham.

By Train: The nearest train station to the venue is Nottingham Railway Station. BGS Keyworth is an approximately 20 minute taxi ride or 30 minute bus journey from Nottingham.

By Bus: Buses to Keyworth run every 15 minutes from Nottingham Railway Station (Stop S4).
